### **CALL FOR ABSTRACTS**

The Capital Region Cancer Research group (CRCR) is presenting a symposium entitled "Precision Medicine in Cancer Treatment and Prevention". This meeting is intended to bring together investigators in the New York Capital Region and beyond who work on various aspects of cancer and will feature seminars by leading cancer research experts, cutting-edge medical oncologists, community-based cancer patient organizations, and selected graduate student and post-doc trainees. The Conference will be chaired by the CRCR, an Inter-institutional organization created to promote interactions and education among Albany area researchers, toward the ultimate goal of contributing to the cure of cancer. CRCR member organizations include Wadsworth Center, University at Albany, General Electric, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, SUNY Polytechnic Institute, Albany College of Pharmacy/PRI, Taconic Biosciences, New York Oncology Hematology, Stratton VA Medical Center, and Albany Medical Center. The conference will be virtual and held on Friday, June 11.

Abstracts are now being accepted from which additional (graduate student and post-doc) symposium speakers will be selected. Abstracts may be on **any topic relevant to cancer research**. Abstracts should be single-spaced and a maximum of 300 words, using a 12-point font and 1-inch margins, and should be submitted no later than Friday, June 4. The title should be all caps and centered, followed by the authors, then affiliation. The program booklet including all submitted abstracts will be available as well as placed on the conference website after the event.
